HSI starts online store

Last year HSI released its landmark compilation CD, *Sounds of Global Worship II*. This new release includes a full-color 27-page booklet of liner notes and pictures, providing the listener with a visual and audio tour of the worship music of sixteen regions of the world. Also available at the site are two other items related to global worship:

1 - *All the World is Singing* -- by HSI leaders Frank Fortunato and Paul Neeley, and Wycliffe editor Carol Brinneman. This book is a collection of articles showing the ways God uses heart language music to transform people. It contains several HSI stories and includes a CD ROM of audio examples and other media illustrations that amplify the stories in the book.

2 - A data DVD compiled by Paul Neeley which provides a vast amount of background materials representing over half of the stories in the book.
